



Visiting our centre in Oxford

The Oxford Assessment Centre is found in Elmfield House, New Yatt Road, Witney, Oxfordshire, OX28 1PB

Local Amenities

The centre provides convenient on-site parking and accessible toilet facilities for visitors. Inside, you'll find a welcoming reception area with a café offering a selection of food and drinks. An outdoor seating area is also available.



By Car

From the M40 Junction 9 or 8 area

Leave the M40 at Junction 8 taking the slip road signposted **Oxford / A40 (towards Oxford)**. Then **Follow the A40 west** past Oxford – the A40 becomes a major dual carriageway. Continue on the A40 for about **10–15 miles** until you reach the **signs for Witney**. Take the **Witney / A4095 exit** off the A40 at the roundabout and follow signs for **Witney town centre / New Yatt Road**. At the next roundabout, **turn onto New Yatt Road** and follow it westwards into Witney. **Elmfield House will be on your left** shortly after passing into the built-up area.

From A40 Cheltenham/Witney Direction

Follow the A40 eastbound towards Witney. You will pass the **Shores Green junction (A4095)** – continue straight ahead following signs for **Witney / Oxford**. Continue on the A40 dual carriageway towards Witney. Take the exit signposted **B4022 / Witney (West) / Brize Norton**. This is the junction just before the Ducklington Lane / Witney west roundabout. At the roundabout at the top of the slip road, take the exit onto **B4022 (New Yatt Road)** towards Witney town centre. Follow **New Yatt Road** into the built-up area for approximately **½ mile**. **Elmfield House will be on your right-hand side** before you reach the town centre. It is a prominent detached office building set back slightly from the road.

From the B4044 (From Swinford Tollbridge cost 5p)

Cross **Swinford Toll Bridge** (toll payable). After crossing the bridge, continue on the **B4044** towards **Eynsham / Witney**. Stay on the B4044 for approximately **4–5 miles**, passing through or alongside **Eynsham**. Continue following signs for **Witney (A40)**. At the roundabout with the **A40**, take the exit onto the **A40 westbound** towards Witney / Cheltenham. Shortly after joining the A40, take the exit signposted **B4022 / Witney (West) / Brize Norton**. At the roundabout at the top of the slip road, take the exit onto **B4022 (New Yatt Road)** towards Witney town centre. Follow **New Yatt Road** for approximately **½ mile** into the built-up area. **Elmfield House will be on your right-hand side**, set slightly back from the road, before reaching the town centre.

By Bus

Get to Witney Town Centre by Inter-Urban Bus

If you're coming from **Oxford, Eynsham or nearby towns** you can catch a regional Stagecoach bus into Witney:

- **Stagecoach S1 or S2** services run between **Oxford and Witney**. They call at **Witney town centre (Market Square)** – typically the main bus hub in Witney.
- These services operate at regular intervals on weekdays (generally every 10–30 minutes for S1 and about hourly for S2) – check the live timetable or bus-planning app.

💡 If you're travelling from Oxford or other nearby towns, use apps like **UK Bus Checker** or **Stagecoach Bus App** to see departure points and times to **Witney Market Square**.

By Taxi

By Train
